Update: Special Dining Arrangements
March 14, 2020

Mayflower is taking advanced precautions with our dining arrangements as the result of new federal guidance and regulations issued in response to Friday's declaration of a National Emergency with the COVID-19 ("coronavirus") situation.

These measures are now in place at Mayflower:

- **Independent Living Buckley Dining Room**
 - Seating will be limited to four (4) people per table. Extra chairs have now been removed from individual tables.
 - This is the result of adhering to "Social Distancing" guidelines that call for separation of parties from each other.
 - At this time, the Monday Neighborhood Dinners will still be hosted, but seating will be disbursed as above.
 - The full Open Dining menu will still be available.
- **Beebe Assisted Living Dining Room**
 - All residents will be served meal trays in their own apartments.
 - We discussed seating one to a table and eating in shifts, but residents opted for service in their apartments instead.
- **Health Center Dining Room**
 - All residents requiring assistance with dining will use the dining room and be seated one person per table.
 - All other residents will be served meal trays in their room suites.
 - Food service staff will continue to take orders from residents using the full Open Dining menu.
