Update #15: COVID-19 Information *June 19, 2020*

As of today, there have been no diagnosed cases of COVID-19 among Mayflower residents or staff.

As we stated in a letter sent out last Friday and affirmed with more information shared in our Facebook Live presentation yesterday, Mayflower is in Phase I of a three-phase "reopening" plan for our Health Center and Beebe Assisted Living.

Kellie will send you a specific update next week about our phases status. In anticipation of moving to Phase II, we will again allow specialists to perform services on the Mayflower campus. However, for independent living residents, we will need to do so in spaces other than the Health Center and Beebe, both of which are still restricted to visitors and will be so in the future when we have any kind of guarantine situation.

We continue to seek new permanent locations for these "clinical" services. In the meantime, we will be using the former "Game Room" in the lower level of Buckley.

 require water in that location. Lynette will offer full-service treatment at her
 offsite location if you prefer. Fee-based transportation is available. Please call or
