ALLOWED

- Compassionate care visits (for endof-life and psycho-social needs) that
 comply with screening upon entry
 and take additional precautions,
 including social distancing and hand
 hygiene. All visitors must wear a
 cloth face covering or face mask for
 the duration of their visit.
- Window visits may be provided under limited and controlled conditions, coordinated by the facility, in consideration of social distancing and universal source control. Note: These limited and controlled visits are not mandated; but rather at the discretion of the facility.
- Virtual visits

Same types of visits as PHASE One plus:

- Limited visitation for residents nearing end of life.
- Limited visitation for residents with significant changes in condition, including those with changing medical status or those experiencing psycho-social issues, such as residents on hospice care or those with significant mental health issues.

Same types of visits as PHASE Two plus:

 Limited-in person visits for all residents that comply with the facility's visitation policy (such as screening procedures, schedule, hours, location, number of visitors and visits, infection control practices, and use of PPE).

NOT ALLOWED

- In-person visits (other than for compassionate care).
- In-person visits (other than for compassionate care or significant changes in condition).
- Unscheduled in-person visits or visits that do not comply with the facility's visitation policies.
