
A brother, a cousin, and their spouses retired at Mayflower, as did many other relatives and dear friends. All were drawn by the warm community and outstanding


Mayflower received charitable contributions totaling \$878,700. between January 1, 2020 and June 1, 2022. The charts illustrate two amazing facts about this generosity.





Annual earnings distributions from HNEF, combined with annual RAF contributions are applied to offset these needs, but typically fall approximately \$200,000 short.
